New Business:

Wes spoke in detail on the problems that occurred at Spring opener. Dave asked for any concerns that needed to be addressed to state on July 1'st. The topics brought by the members were, There was not 2 handicap bathrooms as promised, the one that was there was un accessible for those who truly needed them, people were reserving campsites, which we were told was not allowed, they need to have a lock box in the trailer, they need to advertise there sales for T-shirts and old pins if they want to earn more money, vendors should not be on opposite side, and they need to secure the trailer better. There was concern about gates not being secure enough this year, there was a dog tied up to a brown Suburban all day, and underage people were inside the campground. Some people felt that it was the campground owners fault that the vendors were across the street and Dave told them that this was a spring opener committee decision.
